Assignment Title: Technical assistance in facilitating the Project's participatory implementation cycle, monitoring and oversight with regard to demand driven investments in basic infrastructure and services in selected qishloqs (villages) in Namangan region

The Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan is to implement the Prosperous Villages Project (PVP) with support from the World Bank (WB) and the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) with total funding in the amount of 182,0 million USD. The PVP is being implemented by the Ministry of Economy and Industry (MoEI) through a Project Implementation Unit (PIU) established under the Ministry.

The PIU intends to apply part of the Credit to support facilitating the PVP's participatory implementation cycle, monitoring and oversight with regard to demand driven investments in basic infrastructure and services in selected qishloqs under Component 1 of the Project and seeks to engage the services of a consultant company to assist with implementation of this project component.

The consulting services ("the Services") include the following technical assistance, training, and capacity building activities for Mahalla Citizens Assembly Project Committees (MPCs) and District administration Project Committees (DPCs) in Namangan region:

- a. *Participatory implementation cycle*, including, but not limited to: (i) communications and outreach on Project objectives, rules, and grievance redress system, including to women and vulnerable groups; (ii) participatory needs assessment in all neighborhoods/hamlets in participating qishloqs; (iii) participatory development planning, prioritization, and selection of subproject investments in the form of a Qishloq Development Plan; and (iv) participatory operations and maintenance (O&M).
- b. *Participatory monitoring and oversight*, including, but not limited to, citizen engagement in: (i) subproject monitoring by trained members of MPCs and (ii) social audits, using community scorecards, to ensure that Project decisions are inclusive and transparent, and the accountable use of subproject funds.
- c. *Technical assistance for subproject design and sustainability*, including, but not limited to, (i) basic engineering support to allow for initial environmental and social screening and preliminary subproject design estimates, and (ii) to MPCs to design and implement autonomous water supply and sanitation systems

The Consultant will be hired for a **three-years period**.

The Project Implementation Unit under the Ministry of Economy and Industry of the Republic of Uzbekistan invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- **Technical competence**
- **Management Competence**
- **Project references**
- **Eligibility**

Consultants may submit their EOI as an individual firm or in association in the form of a joint venture or sub-consultancy. All the members of the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire assignment. However, the experience of sub-consultant will not be considered while short-listing. Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Guidelines - Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, dated January 2011 and revised in July 2014.
